Treasurer's Report – Balance in account is \$2,310.39. Rob is working on getting paper statement fee removed from TD Bank.

Committee Reports:

John suggested a flag pole. Dan also mentioned updating/upgrading the gazebo. Any ideas >> forward to Dan & John.
