Ship Bottom News

- Ship Bottom will have free Beach Taxi service available to take physically challenged folks to the beach this summer. These vehicles will transport folks onto the beach where they can meet up with their family. This program will be run by the SBBP out of their headquarters on 26th street. Pickup areas will be oceanside at 3rd, 5th, 11th, 17th, or 31st Streets. From there the individual will be taken over the dune to the appropriate beach to meet with their family/friends who will bring them to their spot on the beach. The reverse will happen when it is time to leave the beach. Reservations will be required in advance. Call (609) 494-9481 to reserve your ride or for any questions.
- **Blue mats** will be installed at 15th and 20th St. These mats create a firmer area for handicapped access to the beach.
- Bike racks have been placed at street ends (ocean side) where possible.
- Bike safety Heavy stock handouts highlighting bike safety have been created and given to the realtors in town to be included in their rental packets
- The new borough hall update it looks like the "move in date" for Borough Hall will be mid summer. The Ship Bottom Post Office will remain closed at the Ship Bottom site for now. All transactions will continue to be done at the main post office in Long Beach Township.
- Once all departments have moved into the new building, the old borough building will be demolished, and a parking lot will be constructed behind town hall.

New Ordinances

ORDINANCE 2023-02 C - provides a structure for charges for duplication of public records and documents

ORDINANCE 2023-03 C – Requires lead paint inspection for single- and two-family homes constructed before 1979 which are used as non-seasonal rental properties.

ORDINANCE 2023-04 C – requires that businesses provide proof of State mandated insurance requirements.

ORDINANCE 2023-05 C – requires installation of "Knox Boxes" to provide key access to businesses and multifamily residential units for first responders to gain access in event of an emergency.

ORDINANCE 2023-07 C – outlines new requirements related to noise within the borough.
