- Once all departments have moved into the new building, the old borough building will be demolished, and a parking lot will be constructed behind town hall.

for now. Once the old building is demolished and the parking lot complete, a loading dock will need to be built behind borough hall and the new post office can open to the public.

New Ordinances

ORDINANCE 2023-13 – regulates setback requirements for on-site storage containers, pavers, air conditioning platforms, etc.

orderendum on the November ballot for Open Space Tax. This tax will be used for acquisition, development and maintenance of lands acquired for recreation and conservation purposes. It can also be used for preservation of historic sites, properties, etc. The tax will be put in a dedicated trust fund that earns interest and will be audited each year.
