### **Ship Bottom Ordinances**

**Ordinance 2025 – 04** – funds allotted to cover the cost of 6 lots on the LBI School property to be allotted to the borough for open space.

**Ordinance 2025 – 05** – temporary outdoor dining allowed during COVID made a more permanent formalized local procedure as per orders from the governor

**Ordinance 2025 – 06** – funding for replacement of water and sewer mains from Long Beach Blvd – Barnegat Av on 7<sup>th</sup> St

**Ordinance 2025 – 07** – funding for repaving of 7<sup>th</sup> St from Long Beach Blvd – Barnegat Av

#### **Explore Barnegat Bay's Wildlife**

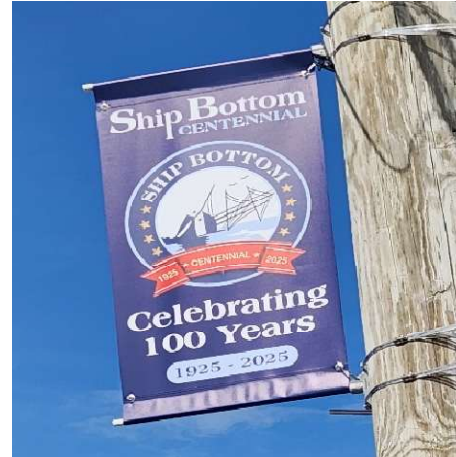

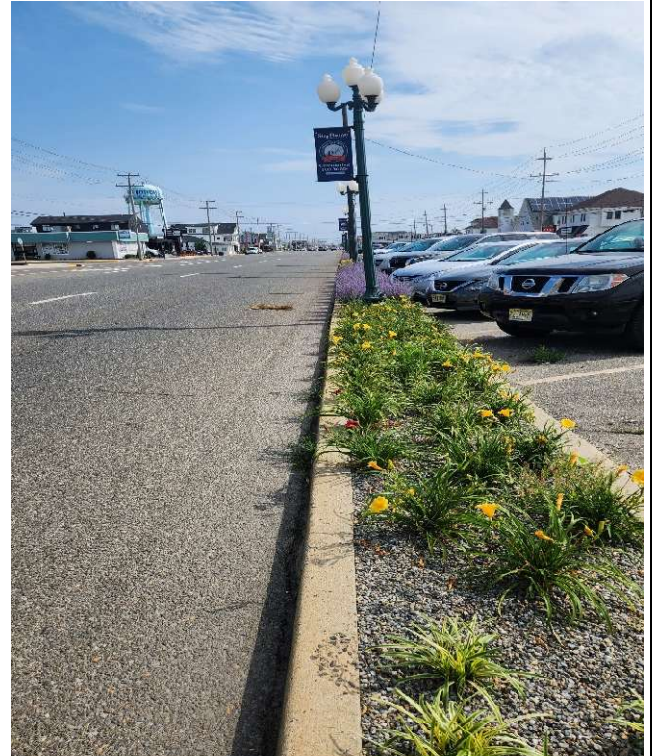
### Enjoy our beaches safely!

**IN-SEASON** (Saturday before Father's Day – Labor Day): Lifeguards are on duty from 10 am to 6 pm daily starting the Saturday before Father's Day up to Labor Day at the following locations:

- 3<sup>rd</sup> Street
- 7<sup>th</sup> Street
- 15<sup>th</sup> Street
- 20<sup>th</sup> Street
- 23<sup>rd</sup> Street
- 26<sup>th</sup> Street
- 30<sup>th</sup> Street
- Bay

**POSTSEASON** Lifeguards are on duty from 10 am to 6 pm daily starting the day after Labor Day through September 30th at the 20<sup>th</sup> Street beach only.

**Never swim without a lifeguard.** Our rip currents can be fatal to even seasoned swimmers.
