

2026 E-BIKE RULES

(effective 7/20/2026)

E-Bike Classes

Pedal-Assist:

Motor assists only when pedaling up to 20 MPH

Throttle Bikes:

Motor can propel bike up to 28 MPH

High-Speed:

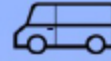
Capable of exceeding 28 MPH

New NJ Law (applies to ALL e-bikes)

- NO ONE under age 15 is permitted to operate an e-bike.
- ALL riders must carry
 - a valid license
 - certificate of registration from MVC* (which requires the display of a license plate on the bicycle)
 - proof of liability insurance
- Riders age 15-16 must obtain a motorized bicycle license from the MVC, requiring a 20-day permit period, a written test, vision test and road test.
- ALL operators of an e-bike are required to wear a helmet.
- ALL e-bikes MUST have a white front light, a red rear light, and a bell or horn.

BIKE SAFETY RULES



- Ride with traffic.



- Riders under 17 MUST wear helmets.



- Obey all traffic signals.



- Stop at all stop signs.



- Use hand signals when making turns.



- MUST have white front and red rear lights for riding at night.



- MUST have a bell or horn.



- Wear bright/visible clothing.



- Bicycles cannot be operated on pedestrian walkways such as sidewalks.



- A mirror is smart but not required.
